

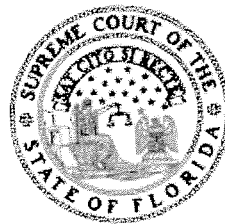


The motion for leave to file brief as amicus curiae filed by The American Bar Association is hereby granted and they are allowed to file brief only in support of Petitioner.

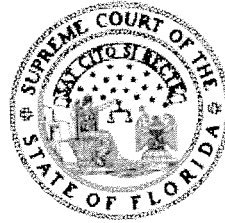
